Marion County rental assistance.

Low income families can get rental assistance in Ocala and Marion County Florida. Individuals who are faced with an eviction, who need help paying for a security deposit, or who are in need of housing counseling can call one of the organizations or programs referenced below for rent and housing help.

Some of the agencies can provide funding to help pay rent in an emergency (such as an eviction), and others can refer people to government homeless prevention programs or housing vouchers, such as section 8. Many of the funds available for paying rent or deposits have waiting lists, and Marion County families need to be found to be eligible for help. It is always recommended to call for help prior to receiving an eviction notice, or before you move and need help with paying for a security deposit. The earlier you ask for rental or housing assistance the more options you will have from the Marion Florida programs.

Annie Johnson Senior Services Center - While funding is limited, Dunnellon area residents may be eligible for free emergency help with paying rent, mortgage, and other housing expenses such as utilities. You can only apply for housing payments at most once per year. 1991 W. Test Court, Dunnellon, Florida, phone 489-8021

Brothers Keeper - A housing counselor is on site for guidance and referrals. In addition, the non-profit may have limited rental assistance. 2 W. Fort King St., Ocala, Florida, call 622-3846

Ocala Office of Department Of Children And Families/Florida Office On Homelessness - This government agency administers the Emergency Financial Assistance For Housing Program in Marion County. The program can provide a one time cash grant/payment of up to \$400 to families who are faced with an eviction. Money is for rent or mortgage payments. Interfaith Emergency Services (Women And Children) - Families in need of emergency assistance can get help. Also runs a 24 hour shelter for women. 435 N.W. Second St., Ocala, telephone 629-8868

Marion County Community Services - Low to moderate income residents can access affordable housing opportunities. Learn about section 8 and local safe and affordable apartments and housing units. CFCC Enterprise Center, 3003 SW College Rd., Ste 109, Ocala, Florida, 671-8770

Ocala Housing Authority - Rental assistance payments are offered to income-eligible residents in Marion County. Also apply for subsidized housing units. 1629 NW 4th, Ocala, phone 369-2636

The Salvation Army/The Center Of Hope - A number of financial assistance, housing and social service programs are administered. Among them include an emergency shelter for men, women and children. The non-profit can also offer emergency rental assistance to people faced with an eviction, or deposits for moving expenses. Other basic needs can be provided for, as well as case management. They also run a transitional housing program for families with children making transition from shelter to independent living. 320 N.W. First Ave., Ocala, 732-8326

Catholic Charities Of Central Florida Family Assistance Office - Regardless of religion, case workers provide resources, grants and financial management counseling, encouraging self-sufficiency, as well as emergency rent/mortgage assistance, cooling bill and utility assistance and food pantry. Call (352) 460-0700

Marion County Homeless Council - Runs the federal government homeless prevention and rapid rehousing program. This includes rent and utility assistance for renters, mortgage foreclosure prevention, and funds for paying security deposits and motel vouchers. It can basically offer interim hotel or motel housing for tenants evicted due to landlord foreclosures. Marion County residents will be required to sustain payments on their own after assistance is rendered. Location is 1740 E Silver Springs Blvd., Ocala, phone 732-1369.

Community Legal Services Of Mid-Florida, Inc. - Areas of free legal assistance for low income residents and seniors includes landlord/tenant issues and eviction prevention. 2300 S.E. 17th Street, Suite 201, Ocala (Tealbrooke Plaza), 629-6257
